2. About the Festival

The Charm of the Hangang — Seoul Global Walking Parade

Walk a 3.0 km course along the Hangang River, where the history of Seoul is still alive, and enjoy health and culture at the same time. This festival is an international walking event open to everyone, regardless of nationality or age.

The course begins at the plaza of Seoul Battleship Park — Seoul's first shipboard theme park, home to a genuine decommissioned warship — and continues along the beautiful riverside trail. Participants who complete the course receive free admission to the Seoul Battleship, making it a memorable day out with family, friends or a partner, taking in both the history and the scenery of Seoul.

Key Points

- A walking event combining heritage and wellness, starting from Seoul Battleship Park — the first shipboard theme park in Seoul
- An international event for Korean and non-Korean participants alike, with separate registration forms for each
- Completely free of charge, open to the first 1,000 registrants
- A participant kit of 6 items, plus free admission to the Seoul Battleship for those who complete the course
- Live performances by Yodel Sister Donghye, hula dance troupe Nā Manu Ka'i Hele, WeNa and Choo Seung-yeop

3. The Walking Course

A 3.0 km loop course starting at Seoul Battleship Park and following the picturesque banks of the Hangang River. Enjoy the open views of Mangwon Hangang Park and the cool river breeze, taking in both a historic site of Seoul and the beauty of its natural surroundings.

※ For your safety, please keep to the pedestrian path. Participants may not occupy both lanes of the cycle path.



4. Participant Kit (6 items)

The participant kit is handed out at on-site registration to those who have registered in advance. Participants who complete the course also receive a free admission ticket to the Seoul Battleship, valid on the event day only.

6. Live Performances

The line-up of celebratory performances for the Seoul Heritage & Wellness Walking Festival.



1) Yodel Sister Donghye

- A familiar face on Korean television, with appearances on programmes including Together with Pengsoo, Running Man and Miss Trot 2. With over twenty years on stage and screen, she has built a following across all ages, from children to older audiences.
- Her set weaves together original yodelling, Korean pop and trot, Disney soundtracks, bubble magic and folk instruments. She tailors each show to the audience and invites them to take part, and her experience as an MC keeps the whole programme running smoothly.

2) Hula Dance — Nā Manu Kaʻi Hele

- Hula means “dance” in Hawaiian. In a culture without a written language, stories were passed down through this dance.
- Now performing widely both in Korea and abroad, the troupe uses dance as a way of connecting people and taking a step towards a better future together.

3) WeNa

- A four-member multinational girl group under RBC Amusement, who debuted in September 2022. The semicolon in their name stands for the bond that holds them together: individual “me”s coming together to form a “we”, with each member bringing her own character to the group.
- Known for striking visuals and high-energy performances, they bring a lively live show that connects with the audience and makes the moment memorable.

4) Choo Seung-yeop

- A vocalist with a distinctive voice and considerable stage presence, built on many years of live performance. He appeared as contestant No. 59 on JTBC's Sing Again 3, where his powerful performances and personal musical style took him to the final top seven.
- Since his official debut in 2008 with the band ACHTUNG, he has released music and performed steadily, earning a reputation as a reliable live performer across broadcasts, concerts and festivals.

8. Getting There

※ There is no dedicated parking for the event and the car park is expected to be very congested. Please use public transport.

Korean place names are given alongside the English so that you can show them to a driver or match them to the signs on the bus.

1) From Mapo-gu Office Station (Line 6)

- Exit 8 — take bus 7011 from the Mapo-gu Office stop (마포구청), get off at Mangwon 1-dong Community Centre (망원 1 동 주민센터), then walk about 14 minutes towards Seoul Battleship Park.

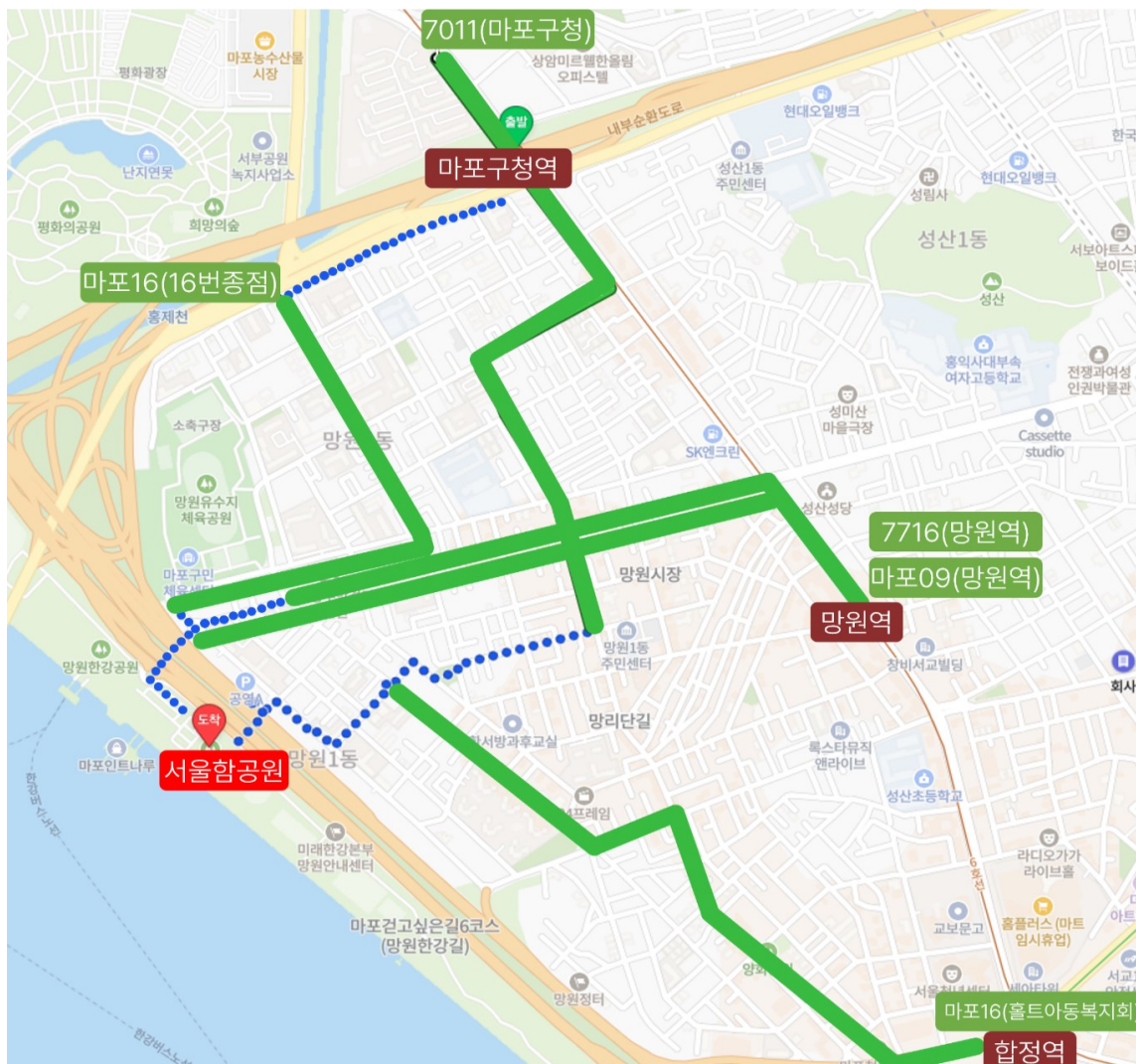
- Exit 6 — take the Mapo 16 minibus from its terminus (마포 16 번 종점), get off at Hangang Bus Mangwon Pier (한강버스 망원선착장), then walk about 6 minutes.

2) From Mangwon Station (Line 6)

- Exit 1 — take bus 7716 from the Mangwon Station stop (망원전철역), get off at Hangang Bus Mangwon Pier (한강버스 망원선착장), then walk about 6 minutes.
- Exit 1 — take the Mapo 09 minibus from the same stop, get off at Hangang Park Entrance (한강공원입구), then walk about 10 minutes.

3) From Hapjeong Station (Lines 2 & 6)

- Exit 8 — take the Mapo 16 minibus from the Holt Children's Services stop (홀트아동복지회), get off at Hwapyeong Church (화평교회), then walk about 8 minutes.
